Who Can Apply: Full-time students, actively pursuing undergraduate studies at Saint Augustine's College who will be classified as first-year seniors in September are eligible to apply. A minimum grade point average of 2.75 is required to apply. The scholarship is open to students regardless of their field of study. See application for more information.
